

# INTRODUCTION TO ART

## “Scooter Girl”

Friday 21 & 28 October 2022

### In this Set of Two Classes:

You will use graphite and/or pastel pencils to create drawing of a child from rear view, with attention to clothing folds, texture and hair.

This is a two week class. In the first class you will plan the composition and draw a light sketch in graphite pencils. In the second class you will work in the tones and details and introduce colour if you wish with pastel pencils or watercolour paints.

### Equipment for This Class:

- Multi-media or Drawing paper – Preferably 300 gsm (or smooth watercolour paper if you would like to add watercolour to the artwork later)
- HB; 2B and 4B or 6B (or higher) Pencils
- Eraser
- Putty Eraser
- Blending stumps
- Ruler
- 2 polythene sleeves to draw reference grids onto with a permanent marker (optional)
- Scale Divider (optional)
- Optional: Set of coloured pastel pencils or paints
