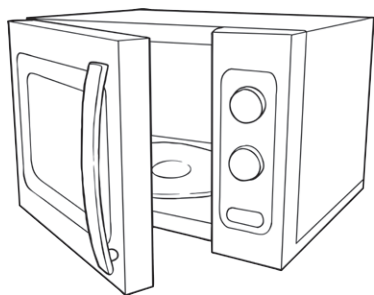
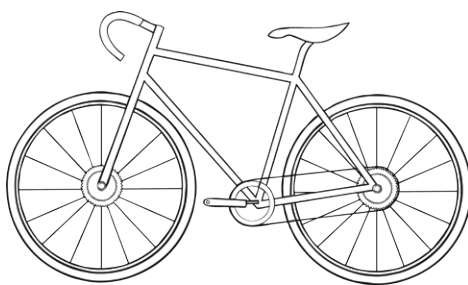

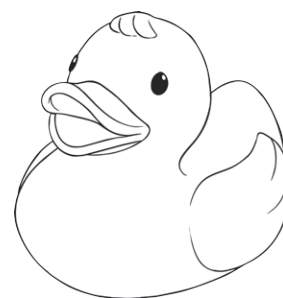
1. Look at the images of the following items. Which room do they belong in?

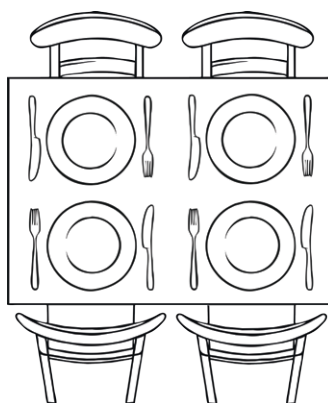

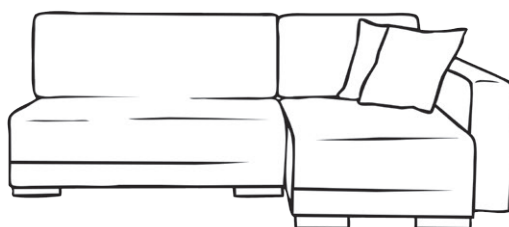
