In French, adjectives generally come after the noun and they must agree in gender and number with the noun they are describing. Here are some examples:

j'ai un cahier noir	I have a black book
j'ai une règle noire	I have a black ruler

Notice how I needed to add an -e to make the adjective feminine to agree with the feminine noun.

j'ai deux cahiers noirs	I have two black books
j'ai deux règles noires	I have two black rules

This time I needed to make sure to add an -s to the adjectives to make them plural.
